Outdoor Dining

We open for outdoor dining! And much of it is heated! Reservations recommended Friday and Saturday nights. The tables with heat are identified via Resy.

- Visit Resy.com and search “Market at the Fareway” to make a reservation.

 - Reservations are available for parties of two to four people.
- The seating area is barricaded. You must enter from the parking lot behind the Chestnut Hill Hotel through the double doors that lead to the front door of the Market at the Fareway.
- Upon arriving, please see host to be seated if you are dining in. If you are purchasing groceries or take-out, please proceed past the host to enter the Market.
- All reservations have an allotted 1.5 hour time slot.
- A server from Chestnut Hill Brewing Company will take your beer and food order. If you would like to order food from another vendor, please enter the Market to place your order.
- All customers must be seated while eating and drinking.
- All customers must wear a mask in the common space but may remove their mask when sitting at your table.
- We are enforcing 6’ social distancing. Please observe the 6’ social distancing out of respect for the other customers and staff.

Indoor Dining

Indoor dining is permitted Saturday, January 16, 2021.

For Your Safety

- All tables are spaced 6' apart.
- Protective barriers are placed at the long communal tables to allow you to safely eat.
- Customers must wear a mask in the common space.
- Please respect the 6' social distancing guidelines.
- All tables will be thoroughly cleaned after each use.
- Bottles of sanitizer placed around the outside seating area to use at your convenience.
- Bus bins available outside. We would greatly appreciate your help to bus the tables.
- All servers will be wearing a mask and washing and sanitizing their hands frequently.

Takeout and Grocery Shopping

- The “pop-in” parking spaces are dedicated for “Call ahead, curbside pick-up only”
- Please adhere to 6' social distancing at all times.
- You must be wearing a mask to enter the Market. If you are unable to wear a mask, please request curbside pick-up as we are not permitted to allow you inside the Market per government orders.
- If you are not feeling well, we ask kindly that you stay home.
- You may also call/text ahead and place your orders and request curbside pick-up.
